That all Person and Persons whomsoever, who now stand in Arrears for Bastardy due to the said Township should be proceeded against according to Law, unless such Arrears be forthwith paid.

That in future all Sum and Sums to accrue and become due for the Support and Maintenance of all such Children, being Bastards, and chargeable to the said Township of Mirfield, must be paid to the Overseers of the Poor of the said Township every Month; and no longer Period will in any case be allowed.--By Order,
