DEATH BY DROWNING.—On Monday last, an inquest was held at the Black Bull Inn, Mirfield, on view of the body of Joseph Buckley, deceased, driver of a hauling horse belonging to Messrs. Thompson and Co., carriers. The boat left Wakefield on Saturday last, on its way back from Hull, and reached a bridge called Hirst's Bridge, about seven in the evening; soon after the boat had passed through, the horse got into the water. The deceased immediately jumped on to the horse for the purpose of bringing it out, when by some means or other he fell off and was drowned. He was taken out of the water in about half an hour. Verdict, "Accidentally Drowned."
