

MICHAEL M'CABE AND THE WEST RIDING MAGISTRATES.—In a letter of Mr. Mathews's (counsel for M'Cube on the late trial), published in this paper last week, the Learned Gentleman says—"It appears that some further inquiries have been made, I believe by the Magistrates in Yorkshire, and sent to the Home-office, the effect of which is unfavourable to M'Cube." Of course, the general impression on reading this passage would be, that the inquiries referred to had been made by the Magistrates in the district where the murders of the Wraiths were committed; but we have reason to know that such an impression would be quite incorrect, and that the majority, at least, of the Magistrates residing near Mirfield, have made no inquiries whatever on this subject.
