

MIRFIELD.—On Sunday week, a new organ, built by Mr. Henry Hopkinson, of Birstal, was opened in Christ church, Mirfield. The services on the occasion were conducted by an amateur choir and organist in a very efficient manner. The organ, which has given high satisfaction to all parties connected with the church, is an exceedingly sweet instrument, and will, no doubt, add greatly to Mr. Hopkinson's reputation as a builder. The following is a list of its stops:—Great organ compass G G to F in alt, 59 notes—1, open diapason ; 2, stop do. ; 3, clarabella ; 4, viol di gamba ; 5, dulciana ; 6, principal ; 7, fifteenth ; 8, cornet ; 9, sesquialtera ; 10, cremona. Swell organ, tenor C to F in alt, 42 notes:—1, open diapason ; 2, stop do. ; 3, double do. ; 4, principal ; 5, hautboy ; 6, trumpet ; 1 octave pedal pipe from C C C, 16 feet upwards, and 1½ octave pedals ; swell couplet, pedal couplet, and four composition pedals.
