COMMITTAL OF A WEST RIDING MAGISTRATE FOR Manslaughter.—On reference to the news under the Dewsbury head in our Supplement of this day, it will be seen that a coroner's jury have found a verdict of manslaughter against Joshua Ingham, Esq., of Blake Hall, Mirfield, deputy chairman of the West Riding Magistrates at the quarter sessions, for a fatal accident which occurred to a boy on Mr. Ingham's tram road, through his alleged neglect. Mr. Ingham, the stipendiary magistrate at the Thames Police-court, attended at the inquest on behalf of his brother, and made a long and impressive speech on his behalf, notwithstanding which the jury were unanimous in their verdict. We understand that Mr. Ingham is at present in a very precarious state of health, and is in the south of England, and that bail was to have been entered into yesterday (Friday) for his appearance at the ensuing York Assizes to take his trial.
