RAILWAY Accident.—On Monday last, a serious accident happened to an aged woman residing at Mirfield, who was attempting to cross the line of rails which run over a footpath leading from Mirfield-lane. Several persons were on the spot at the time waiting on either side of the rails for the train to pass, which was but a short distance from them; and it seems that the old woman, either unthinkingly or very imprudently attempted to cross before either the bystanders had time to caution her or the engine driver to stop the train, when she was knocked down by the buffer of the engine, and very severely injured in different parts of her body. She was immediately carried to her own home, which is but a short distance from the place of the accident, where she still lies in a very precarious state.
