

**LONGEVITY.**—There are now residing in the healthy village of Mirfield 38 persons, whose united ages amount to 3,114 years, the average being 81 years and 10 months. One of them is aged 96, two 88, two 86, one 85, five 84, two 83, four 82, nine 81, two 80, four 79, four 78, and two 77 years. The majority of these are very hale, and engaged in active life. It may be interesting to many of our readers to learn that this is one of the most healthy and beautiful villages in Yorkshire. The extreme beauty of its woodland scenery, and its salubrious air, will ere long induce many of those who are engaged in business in the neighbouring towns to make this lovely district the favourite place for their private residence. In 1832, when the surrounding towns and villages were visited with cholera, only two cases appeared in Mirfield; and not one in 1849, when so many persons in its neighbourhood were swept away by that dreadful malady.
