Inquest.—On Saturday last, an inquest was held at the King's Head Inn, Mirfield, before Thos. Lee, Esq., coroner, on the body of Hannah Gill, the daughter of John Gill, of Knowl. For some time back the deceased had been out in service, and on the previous Wednesday was taken ill, when her mother was sent for, and she took her home. During the night deceased was seen several times by her mother, and about two o'clock on Thursday morning she appeared to have fallen asleep, when the mother went to bed; but on going to her when she got up in the morning, she found her dead in bed. No evidence being adduced as to the cause of death, the jury returned a verdict of "Found dead."
