

CAUTION TO WAGGON DRIVERS.—On Monday last, at the Court-house, William Denton, of Huddersfield, was charged by Mr. Bradbury, surgeon, Mirfield, with riding on his waggon on the Dewsbury and Ealand turnpike road, on the 23rd September. On the evening of that day, Mr. Bradbury was returning home in his gig, when he met the defendant's waggon, upon which he was riding, and which was also on the wrong side of the road; and, upon remonstrating with Denton, he and also a person called John Field, who was riding on the waggon with Denton assaulted Mr. Bradbury. Denton, for riding on the waggon, was fined £2 and costs, and both Denton and Field, for the assault, were fined £1 each, and 16s. costs, or in default of payment to be imprisoned one month.
