FATAL ACCIDENT AT MIRFIELD.—On Tuesday last, an inquest was held at the house of Mr. Ernest Kindler, the New Inn, Newtown, Mirfield, before Thomas Taylor, Esq., coroner, on the body of Richard Fearnley, aged 22 years. The deceased was employed at the mill of Mr. Edward Hemingway, and, about ten o'clock on the morning of the previous day, along with a person named Crabtree, arranged to clean a carder. Crabtree threw the strap off the machine, and by some means deceased was caught and taken twice round the drum. The strap then broke, and he fell on the floor quite dead, having in his way round the drum struck his head against and knocked down a steam pipe. A verdict of "Accidental death" was returned.
