The persons appointed will be entitled to cortain extra fees, the particulars of which and also the auties of the office, and the boundaries of the districts, may be known on application to the Clerk of the Guardians. And each person appointed will be required to enter into a contract for the vaccination of persons resident in his district at the sum of one shilling and sixpence for every person successfully vaccinated.
