

TRIP TO KIRKLEES PARK.—About 700 persons proceeded, under the auspices of the Bradford district of the Ancient Order of Foresters, from Bradford, on Saturday afternoon, to Kirklees Park, the seat of H. W. Wickham, Esq., M.P. These were joined by some 3,000 from the neighbourhood of the Park. The Bradford party went by special train on the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway to Cooper Bridge, and thence to the Park, accompanied by the Bowling ironworks brass band, the Phoenix foundry brass band, and the New Leeds fife and drum band. The afternoon was pleasantly spent: there was an archery fête, Robin Hood's grave and the grave of the three sisters were visited, and the gardens were thrown open to the visitors. The balance of proceeds, after payment of expenses, will be presented to the Bradford Infirmary.
