THE ROBBERIES FROM THE MIRFIELD RAILWAY STATION.—On Thursday last, Charles Brearley, of Brighouse, and William Doughty, of Mirfield, were arraigned before J. B. Greenwood, Esq., charged with being concerned in the robberies which have lately been committed at the Mirfield station. Mr. Chambers appeared for the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, and stated that within the last eight or nine weeks property to the amount of £200 had been missed from the Mirfield station, but the case not being complete, he requested a remand. Some evidence of stolen property having been found in the prisoner's possession, part of which consisted of bottles and decanters stolen from the refreshment rooms in December last, the prisoners were remanded until Monday.
