GAME OFFENCE.—On Monday last, Milner Senior, of Hopton, was charged at Dewsbury, by Joe Wolfenden. gamekeeper to Henry Frederick Beaumout, Esq., of Whitley Hall, with using a gun for the purpose of killing game. On the evening of the 7th August Wolfenden heard two shots fired in the direction of Hepworth wood, in Hopton, and he and another man went in the direction of the wood and saw Senior come out of it with a double barreled gun. Senior was stopped by Wolfenden, to whom he offered to give some money to make the matter up. Several witnesses were called for the defendant, but they rather strengthened than rebutted the case against him. A fine of £1 and costs (or one month's imprisonment) was imposed.
