THUNDER-STORMS. — The thunder-storms which have passed over this district during the week have done considerable damage. The windows at Blake Hall suffered to the extent of above a thousand squares, and in the windows of E. B. W. Balme, Esq., of Cate Wall, and Mrs. Fairburn, of Royds House, also large quantities of squares were broken. At the mill and weaving shed of Mr. Henry Wheatley, of Hopton, it is supposed the damage will be £100. At the Calder Farm Reformatory School, and also at many private houses squares of glass were broken. Growing crops have also suffered, especially beans and potatoes, and fruit trees are injured to some extent.
