CALDER FARM SCHOOL REFORMATORY.—ACCIDENT.—On Saturday, about noon; as the boys were carting wood in a neighbouring planting, one of them fell under the wheel, and sustained such a serious fracture of the leg, that amputation was deemed necessary, and the operation was performed under the influence of chloroform the same afternoon, by Mr. Marsden, the surgeon to the institution, and the progress of the case is perfectly satisfactory. Under the chloroform the boy saw the greatest portion of the operation, and was entirely free from pain or apprehension, and remained perfectly quiet without being held.
