FATAL ACCIDENT AT MIRFIELD.—An inquest was held last night, at the Wilson's Arms Inn, Mirfield, before Mr. Taylor, coroner, on the body of an infant, son of Saml. Wood, waterman, of that village. The evidence showed that, on Saturday afternoon, a large bowl of boiling hot wort or beer was placed at Wood's house door to cool, and that the infant, having got to it, lost its balance, and fell into the scalding liquor. It was taken out at once, and Mr. Ellis, surgeon, of Mirfield, sent for, but death put an end to its sufferings on Sunday morning at nine o'clock. The jury returned a verdict of "Accidental death."
