

**ALLEGED STACK FIRINGS AT MIRFIELD.** — On Thursday night a wheat stack, the property of Mr. Richard Hurst, maltster, of Mirfield, was totally consumed by fire—the action, it is supposed, of an incendiary. The stack was in a yard, near some seven or eight others, and had there been much wind all must have been destroyed. In consequence of certain suspicious circumstances the police were called in, and Superintendent Martin, after an inquiry, felt himself justified in arresting Martha Gledhill, a milliner, aged twenty-eight years, who lives with her mother, about 400 yards from the stack-yard. Between the Gledhills and the Hursts there has of late been a feud about a certain right of road, and a quarrel took place between them and Mr. Hurst a few hours before the stack was burned, and in which Miss Gledhill took a prominent part. The affair has caused a good deal of excitement in the neighbourhood.
