

THE LATE FATAL ACCIDENT TO A DEWSBURY GENTLEMAN.—The adjourned inquest upon the body of Mr. J. O. Gill, mining engineer and surveyor, of Dewsbury, whose death by drowning, at Mirfield, was reported a fortnight ago in the *Mercury*, took place yesterday, at the Black Bull Hotel, Mirfield. There was no further evidence offered, and it did not appear that the persons responsible for the state of the bridge over the canal (where the deceased met his death) and the roadway had been pointed out. The jury returned a verdict of "Accidental death."
