

**A MAN DROWNED.**—An inquest was held on Monday at the Ship Inn, Mirfield, before Mr. Skipenton, deputy coroner, on the body of Chas. Turner, weaver. Evidence was laid before the jury to show that on Whit-Tuesday he was last seen alive,—he was then near the Royal Hotel, Ravensthorpe, Mirfield. He was apparently sober, but seemed in a brown study. He was regarded as a rather eccentric character, and on that occasion attracted very little notice. On Sunday morning his body was found in the river Calder, and as there was no evidence to show how he met with his death—whether by design on his part or accident—an open verdict was returned by the jury.
