THE LATE FIRE AT MIRFIELD.—The fire at Messrs. Simpson's mill, Mirsteld, which broke out on Friday night, was extinguished about two o'clock on Saturday morning. That portion of the structure which remains entire was insured in the Sun office, and the other in the Royal and the Scottish Union. The origin of the conflagration is unknown. Fire was first seen in the upper storey, but through the want of water the men working on the premises were unable to stay its progress. The damage is estimated at between £15,000 to £20,000. No accident to life or limb occurred.
