

THE BODY OF A MAN FOUND IN THE RIVER CALDER.—Yesterday an inquest was held at the Three Nuns Inn, Mirfield, before Mr. Thomas Taylor, coroner, touching the death of a man, named Benjamin Naylor, whose body was found in the river Calder, near Nunbrook, Mirfield, on Thursday. It appeared from the evidence that the deceased left his home, which was in the neighbourhood of Mirfield, on the 13th of October last, and that on the 14th his clothes were found on the river bank, near Kirkless-bar. Search for the body had been made in the interval, but, as stated above, it was not discovered until Thursday. The jury returned a verdict, "Drowned himself whilst labouring under temporary insanity."
