

MELANCHOLY DEATH. — Yesterday afternoon, about two o'clock, a fatal accident occurred near Mirfield, on the branch line of the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway being constructed between Thornhill and Heckmondwike. A waggon, laden with large blocks of stone, was being turned on a turning table by several men, when one of the blocks rolled off the waggon, and struck an Irish labourer named Kelley on the head, cleaving the upper portion of the skull. The unfortunate man only lived a few minutes after.
