MIRFIELD UNITED METHODIST FREE CHURCH. In connection with this place of worship four memorial stones of a new Sunday school were laid at New Scarbro', Mirfield, on Monday afternoon, in the presence of a considerable number of spectators. The inaugural address was delivered by the Rev. John Guttridge (of Manchester), atter which Mrs. Edwards, Leeds (to whom a silver trowel and a mallet were presented by Mr. J. Horton), laid the first stone. The second stone was laid by Mrs. Hortou (Mirfield), who received a silver trowel and a mallet at the hands of Mr. John Ashworth, of Rochdale. Mrs. J. B. Waite laid the third stone, and to this lady the Rev. John Guttridge presented a silver trowel and a mallet. The fourth stone was laid by Miss Cowburn, Liversedge. Miss Cowburn was the recipient of a similar present to those received by the ladies already named. The presentation in this instance was made by the Rev. E. Bailey. Mr. John Ashworth then gave an address, after which a great portion of the congregation adjourned to the New Connexion Schoolroom, where they partook of tea. In the evening a public meeting was held in the Town Hall, and the chair was occupied by Mr. W. H. Conyers, of Leeds. The gathering was addressed by the Revs. B. Baker, John Guttridge, R. Cameron, J. Coultas, S. Newton, J. H. Morgan, H. S. Albrecht, LL D.; and Messre. J. Horton, John Ashworth, J. Cook, W. Edwards, and others. The cost of the building is estimated at £1,100, and towards this sum £198 3s, has been raised.
