RECOVERY OF TWO BODIES AT MIRFIELD .--During this week two dead bodies have been recovered from some water at Colne Bridge, near Mirfield, and it would seem that one death has been the result of an accident, or carelessness, and there is no positive evidence as to the other occurrence. On Monday the body of a child, aged one year and, nine months, son of Mr. Philip Thewlis, was taken out of a water dam belonging to Messrs. Thomas Haigh and Son. It appears that the child had been observed playing near the dam side, and had been called out of danger several times; but it is evident it must have returned to the place, as it was seen about five minutes atterwards in the water. It was immediately rescued, but life was extinct. The body of an apparently still-born child was found on the damstakes at Coine Bridge on Tuesday,
