

DEWSBURY.-- Owing to the extraordinary fall of rain on Friday night, the river Calder overflowed its banks on Saturday, causing a large amount of damage. The river rose higher than has been the case for eleven years. The basements of several buildings were filled with water, and the meadows adjoining the river were flooded. At Mirfield the roadway at Shepley Bridge was covered with water, rendering travelling impossible. A large quantity of wheat was washed down the river.
