

BREAKING INTO A RAILWAY BOOKING-OFFICE.
Yesterday a young man named Sam Smithson, said to be well connected, was brought up at the Dewsbury Borough Court before the Mayor (Ald. John Haigh), charged with breaking into the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company's booking office at Ravensthorpe station, and stealing therefrom the sum of fourpence. The prisoner, it seems, got into the office by breaking a window at an early hour on Tuesday morning, but the noise he made attracted the attention of a signaller, who went to the place, and seeing somebody inside fetched the station master, and the prisoner was given into custody. Prisoner pleaded guilty, and said that "something tempted him like." He was committed to jail for six weeks with hard labour.
