

A LEEDS LUNATIC IN TROUBLE AT DEWSBURY.
Yesterday, at the West Riding Court-house, Dewsbury, a man, apparently of unsound mind, named Jonathan Swallow, who said he belonged to Leeds, was charged with travelling on the railway without a ticket from Dewsbury to Mirfield on the 3rd inst. A foreman porter at Mirfield station named Smith proved that on the day named the prisoner came by the 1.34 train from Dewsbury, and on witness demanding his ticket, he said he had not got one. He asked him where he was going to, and he could not tell, or give any account of himself.—The prisoner made a rambling statement to the Bench to the effect that he was being brought from Leeds to the Asylum at Wakefield, but had escaped. He was remanded, in order that further inquiries might be made about him.
