

FATAL TERMINATION OF AN ACCIDENT.—Yesterday morning, about half-past eight, George Stead, a goods inspector at Mirfield Station, died at the Huddersfield Infirmary from injuries he received at Mirfield on the 21st of January, whilst he was superintending the shunting of some waggons, by being knocked down and run over. He sustained a compound fracture of both legs, and the toes of his left foot were smashed. The right leg had to be amputated the same night, and a portion of the left foot had also to be cut away. The left leg had afterwards to be amputated. The deceased leaves a wife and three children, and he was thirty-three years of age.
