DEWSBURY.

Defrauding a Railway Company.—At the West Riding Court on Friday, Jas. Firth, veterinary surgeon, of Mirfield, was convicted of having ridden in a carriage of the London and North-Western Railway Company from Dewsbury to Mirfield without having previously paid his fare, and with intent to defraud the company. It was proved that on the 11th ult. he arrived at Mirfield by the last train, and leaving the carriage he was seated in, on the off side, attempted to get away unobserved; but he was seen by a porter and reported. The Bench fined him 20s. and costs.
