

## A CORN MILL DESTROYED BY FIRE AT RAVENSTHORPE.

A fire broke out last night at Messrs. Hirst Bros.' corn mills, Ravensthorpe. The alarm was given at 11.45, but the efforts of the firemen were in vain so far as attempting to save the property was concerned, as the building was totally destroyed in about an hour. The premises contained about six thousand bags of wheat and flour, which had been stored there during the past fortnight. The loss is supposed to amount to about £15,000. The wind was fortunately blowing west, and the flames were driven across the canal, which runs by the mill, otherwise the property of Messrs. Day and Fox would have been in great danger. It was only a fortnight since that a warehouse belonging to the same firm was destroyed at Deighton, near Huddersfield.
