THE DISTURBANCES NEAR DEWSBURY. — In anticipation of a renewal of the disturbances by the colliers on strike at the Dark-lane Colliery, Ravensthorpe, a large force of the county and borough police proceeded to the place yesterday for the purpose of protecting the non-unionist men when they left work. A crowd assembled near the colliery yard, and when a man and two boys left the pit they were escorted to their homes at Dewsbury by the police, followed by the crowd, but no breach of the peace took place.
