IMPORTANT TO CAB PROPRIETORS.—Yesterday, at the West Riding Police-court, Dewsbury, George Henry Bywater, of Mirfield, was summoned for driving a cab along the public highway there and not being licensed. The proceedings were instituted by the Mirfield Local Board, and Mr. Ibberson appeared on their behalf, Mr. Moore, of Halifax, being for the defendant. Defendant was fined 10s. and costs. Summonses against Mr. Strother, his employer, and Mr. W. Tattersfield, for allowing their cabs to apply for hire, were withdrawn, on payment of costs, by the Local Board, through Mr. George Armitage, their chairman, who is also clerk to the Justices.
