

**MYSTERIOUS DROWNING CASE NEAR DEWS-BURY.**—On Saturday afternoon the body of a man unknown was found in the lock at Shepley Bridge of the Calder and Hebble Canal. It was much decomposed, and appears to have been in the water for several months. The discovery was made by two little boys, who told the lock-keeper, and he fetched the police. The body was removed to the Ship Inn, Shepley Bridge. The corpse is believed to be that of Isaac Peal, factory operative, of Elland, who was missed last December, and advertised for in the *Police Gazette* of January 9th. It corresponds in appearance with the description given of Peal, whose relations were communicated with on Saturday evening. Information was also sent to the Coroner.
