FAILURE IN THE YORKSHIRE YARN TRADE.

Weiregret to say that Mesers. Isaac Buckley and Sons. Ravensthorpe, an old-established firm, have, owing to trade losses and bad trade, been unable to meet their liabilities. Mesers. Chadwick and Sons, solicitors, Dewsbury, filed a petition on their behalf in the Dewabury Bankruptoy Court yesterday. The debtors, who carried on business at the Ravenswharfe Mills as worsted yarn spinners, are involved to the amount of about £28,000, the assets being estimated at £18,000. Some time ago a private meeting of creditors was held, when it was agreed to accept 10s. in the pound, but debtors had been unable to pay. The Registrar made a receiving order.
