THE LATE MUTINY AT MIRRIELD REFORMA-TORY .- Yesterday, at the Dewsbury West Riding Policecourt, four youths under sentences of detention at the Calder Farm Reformatory School, Mirfield, viz., Alfred Crowther, William Henry Cunliffe, Samuel Staley, and Benjamin Richardson, were charged with absconding from that institution on Sunday, the 15th inst., and the latter was charged with assaulting Mr. Lockwood, one of the labour masters, on the same occasion. They all pleaded guilty. Prisoners and thirteen others ran away, having first attempted to throw the labour master over a wall after he had been wounded on the head with a stone. Richardson, the ringleader, was sentenced to three months, Crowther to fourteen days, and the other two to one month's imprisonment.
