

A DANGEROUS DOG.—Mr. Augustus Mann, of Mirfield, spirit merchant, was summoned before the Dewsbury West Riding Justices on Friday for allowing a ferocious dog to go at large unmuzzled. The animal, it appeared, had long exhibited vicious propensities. In April, 1885, defendant was warned by the police of this, but it was not thought necessary to take proceedings. Recently, it bit several people, mostly children, and on Thursday last week attacked and bit six, and “shook one like a rag.” Defendant denied that it had done anything of the kind. He was fined 40s. and costs, or one month’s imprisonment.
