A DEWSBURY MAY DROWNED AT MIRFIELD.-Yesterday an inquest was held at the Ship Inn, Mirfield, on view of the body of Joseph O'Connor, labourer, of Dawgreen. On the 29th January the deceased left a grocer's shop, near Shepley Bridge, at eleven o'clock at night. He was not seen again until his body was found floating in the river on Monday by a person named Rothery. It is supposed that he fell into the water in attempting to get on a boat where he was accustomed to sleep. A verdict of "Found drowned, without any marks of violence," was returned.
