FELONY AT DEWSBURY.—At Dewsbury yester-day, Granger Green, labourer, Mirfield, was charged with stealing an anvil from an outbuilding on the colliery premises of Messrs. G. and H. Haigh, Flushdyke, on the 4th inst. The prisoner sold the anvil to a broker named Ashton, at Flushdyke, for 9s., the real value being estimated at 50s. Prisoner said he took the anvil because he was out of employment, and required food for his wife and family. He was sent to gaol for six months.
