

FUNERAL OF MR. J. IBBERSON AT MIRFIELD.—

Yesterday the remains of Mr. J. Ibberson, solicitor, and late clerk to the West Riding Justices at Dewsbury, were interred in the family vault in the grave-yard of the Mirfield Parish Church. The funeral was very largely attended. Several of the West Riding magistrates and some of the Dewsbury Borough Bench were present; and almost every member of the legal profession practising in the district attended. The Mirfield Masonic Lodge, of which the deceased gentleman was a member, was represented; and also the lodge of the Three Grand Principles, Dewsbury. Superintendent Airtou, three sergeants, and about 30 constables belonging to the West Riding Constabulary, were in attendance; and 10 of the latter conveyed the coffin from the hearse to the grave. The funeral service was conducted by the Rev. F. R. Greuside, Vicar.
