OUTBREAK OF FEVER IN MIRFIELD.—Last night, at a meeting of the Mirfield Local Board, Mr. Joshua Milner in the chair, the Medical Officer reported three cases of typhoid tever, and one each of scarlet fever, diphtheria, and crysipelas. They were chiefly in Hopton. The necessary instructions were given to prevent any further spread of these zymotic diseases. It was resolved to write to the County Council and ask them to reserve to Mirfield a proportionate share of the money to be allotted by Government for the purposes of technical education.
