

MIRFIELD CHORAL SOCIETY.—On Wednesday evening this society performed “The Great Day of the Lord,” a sacred cantata, composed by the conductor of the society, Mr. H. C. Ainley, Mus. Bac. Cantab. The idea is to represent the coming of our Lord at the last great day. The work, which is divided into three parts, is a scholarly composition, and, under the training of the composer, had a praiseworthy rendering in the Town Hall, before a large audience.
