MIRFIELD LIBERAL CLUB.—The annual meeting was held last evening, Mr. W. Wilson, the president, in the chair. The report read by Mr. Alian Kaye, the secretary, showed an increase of 81 members during the year, and a corresponding increase in the subscriptions and the receipts in the refreshment department of the club.—A resolution was afterwards adopted on the motion of Mr. G. H. Tattersfield, seconded by Mr. G. E. Walker, congratulating the Government on having, in the face of unprecedented opposition, carried the Home Rule Bill through the House of Commons. and expressing the opinion that in rejecting it the House of Lords had provided a tangible reason for its own extinction; also trusting that the Government would not rest satisfied until they had carried the measures sketched out in the Newcastle programme.
