AUCIDENT TO LADY ARMYTAGE, OF KIRK-LEES, CLIFTON.—On Sunday, at noon, as Lady Armytage, of Kirklees, Clifton, Brighouse, was driving home after attending service at St. Joseph's Catholio Church, what might have proved a very serious accident happened. The carriage and pair in charge of the coachman and groom were proceeding along Wakefieldroad, when the horses shied at some lads who were swinging on the branch of a tree, and the horses swerving, jumped over the wall into a field. Lady Armytage was thrown out into the road, and the coachman and groom were also thrown from their seats. Happily, none of them was seriously injured, aithough Lady Armytage was severely shaken, and had to be removed home in a cub. The groom and coachman were none the worse for the mishap, but the shafts and strappings were broken. On inquiry vesterday, it transpired that Lady Armytage seemed little the worse for the accident.
