

FAMILY QUARREL AT MIRFIELD.—An offer to buy two pennyworth of landanum made by James Belfield, at the Wellington Hotel, Mirfield, on the 26th ult., led to his appearance yesterday at the West Riding Court-house, Dewsbury, on a charge of assaulting Lister Belfield, a relative, to whom the offer was preferred.
